1. **TVA has furnished** a sign for the Club property, which displays the TVA 1-800 number for emergencies.

3. **TVA property is a wildlife-protected area (TWRA)**
4. **Everyone must scan their gate card to enter the Club**
5. **No metal targets/plates closer than the 50 yds.**  
Bianchi Plates no closer than 25 yds.  
Metal animal targets are for **cast bullets only**.
6. **Wood benches are for gear only, not bench rest.**
7. **TVA range across the street is off limits**
