NOTICE: Club announcements

1. TVA has furnished a sign for the Club property, which displays the TVA 1-800 number for emergencies.
2. No Member is to ask a TVA employee to open the gate to the club. They do not have that authority.
3. TVA property is a wildlife-protected area (TWRA)
4. Everyone must scan their gate card to enter the Club
5. No metal targets/plates closer than the 50 yds.
Bianchi Plates no closer than 25 yds.
Metal animal targets are for cast bullets only.
6. Wood benches are for gear only, not bench rest.
7. TVA range across the street is off limits

Use Target Stands only for setting up Targets. Do not use rocks, blocks etc. which are a safety hazard. Pick up after shooting for mowing.
