Metal Targets and Plates at Range.

No metal targets/plates shot closer than the 50 yds.

Exceptions are 22cal spinners, sanctioned matches, and Bianchi Plates.

The metal animal targets are for cast bullets only.

You are responsible for damage to targets.

Bianchi Plates: shot at minimum of 15 yd. No magnums or rifles. Must shoot directly in front of plates.

Thanks for keeping the range clean.

Most are doing a great job picking up their targets and empty cases. Mowing season is here and we must keep the range clean, especially bowling pens.
