Varmint for Score Benchrest Match Sat. October 20

There will be **2 classes**: Benchrest Class under 13.5 lbs, and Varmint/Hunting Rifle Class. There are no caliber requirements. 50 rounds for score plus unlimited sighters during relays (would bring 50 to 70 rounds for sighters)

100 yd Match: 5 ten-minute relays of 5 rounds for score and unlimited sighters for a total of 250 points. Each relay will have 1 IBS VFS target consisting of one sighter bull and 5 record bulls for a total of 50 points each relay. Match winners are to be decided by score, then score plus "X" count, then miss and out starting with bull number one and continuing through bull five, etc. Scoring will be "best edge" where inside or touching the ring counts.

200 yd Match: (will be the same as the 100 yd match except larger targets)

Fees: Range fee is \$10 for the day. The match fees are \$10 (for each match) with all match fees going back as prize money 50/30/20% to the first 3 places of the match. Each class splits their own match fees.

High Power/Military Match Saturday Sat. October 27

All stages will be fired at 200 yd, using the appropriate reduced scale targets for the 300 yd and 600 yd stage of the match. Range fee for the day is \$10 for members and \$15 for nonmembers.

National Match Course consists of 10 rounds slow fire standing: 10 rounds rapid fire sitting or kneeling; 10 rounds rapid fire prone and 20 rounds slow fire prone. 50 rounds total for score with a 20–30 minute sight in period before the match starts.

Equipment - Rifle: Center fire rifles to be used in high power rifle competition must be equipped with metallic sights. They should be capable of holding at least 5 rounds of ammunition and should be adapted to rapid reloading. AR-15's are the most popular rifle for this match. So are M-1 Garand, M14/M1A, 1903/A3 Springfield, Mausers, etc.

We want to encourage young and inexperienced shooters who are new to competitive rifle shooting to participate and have a good time. Experienced Hi-power shooters will be present to help and teach new shooters.
